

2016 List of Grants

- 1. Blackpool 6th Form College (Blackpool)**
A single grant of £1,550 to introduce Classical Civilisation clubs in 2 primary and Latin in 2 secondary schools reaching 80 primary and 60 secondary school pupils
- 2. Chew Valley School (Bristol)**
Two annual grants of £4,500, and £2,400 to support the introduction of Latin clubs in 5 primary schools in the Chew Valley reaching 160 young people and 6 teachers
- 3. Dixon's Trinity Academy (Bradford)**
A grant of £6,340 over three years to support the introduction of GCSE Latin for 8 pupils and to work with 3 primary schools to introduce Latin
- 4. Durham University (Durham)**
A single grant of £5,681 to support the introduction of classical study in 9 Durham primary schools
- 5. Eastbourne Schools Partnership (East Sussex)**
A single grant of £2,000 to support the development of Latin in Ratton Secondary school and in three local primary schools
- 6. Exeter College (Exeter)**
A single grant of £2,134 to support the introduction of Latin clubs in 5 local primary schools with up to 150 pupils
- 7. Greig City Academy (Haringey, London)**
A single grant of £3,400 to develop and pilot a new Classics course for Key Stage 2 students in 3 North London primary schools that will be rolled out more widely
- 8. Harris Dulwich (London)**
A grant of £2,500 over 2 years to introduce Latin at Key Stage 3 for 75 and GCSE Latin for 6 pupils
- 9. Harris Girls' Academy Bromley (London)**
A single grant of £2,418 to support the training of 4 Latin teachers
- 10. Ouseburn Learning Trust and Heaton Manor School (Newcastle upon Tyne)**
A single grant of £5,000 to introduce Latin at 4 primary school feeder schools and one local secondary school.
- 11. JCoss (Jewish Community Secondary School, London)**
Two grants of £3,750 to support the introduction of Classical Civilisation at A Level for 10 pupils

12. **Inspiration Trust (Charles Darwin Primary School, Norwich)**
A single grant of £4,500 to support the introduction of Latin in five of the Trust's feeder schools to over 400 pupils at Key Stage 2
13. **Luton 6th Form College (Luton)**
A single grant of £4,818 to support a Latin club for pupils from 6 secondary schools and the introduction of Latin in Challney Secondary school
14. **Royal Grammar School High Wycombe (Buckinghamshire)**
A grant of £3,902 in year one and £3,935 in year two to establish a Greek course for up to 6 pupils, to introduce an after schools classics club for pupils at Key Stage 3 and to run Latin training for local primary schools
15. **St Ivo School (Cambridgeshire)**
A grant of £3,750 in year one and £2,250 in year two to support the introduction of Classical Civilisation at A level for up to 10 pupils
16. **St Mark's Church of England primary school (Cumbria)**
A single grant of £1,000 to introduce a Classical Civilisation Club for 30 pupils at Key Stage 2
17. **St Peter's RC High School & Sixth Form Centre (Gloucestershire)**
A single grant of £2,000 to support the introduction of Classical Civilisation at Key Stage 3
18. **Swansea University (Wales)**
A grant of £29,225 over 2 years to train 50 teachers and develop Classics provision in 10 primary schools
19. **Wyedean School (Gloucestershire)**
A single grant of £5,500 to introduce Classics in 4 primary schools
