



## ONLINE CLASSICS TRAINING

Free CPD for state school teachers

4 x 2 hour sessions, running Tuesday 23rd - Friday 26th August

Classics for All, a national charity which works to widen access to classical subjects, is offering free online training this summer to support the teaching and learning of Classics. These online courses will replace our popular Latin & Greek language courses, held annually at Harrow School in August. This year, we have expanded our programme to offer courses on Primary Latin, GCSE Latin Literature set texts and A Level Classical Civilisation.

This training is open to anyone who is teaching in state schools and colleges in the UK. Whether you are interested in introducing Latin, Ancient Greek or Classical Civilisation into your school or college for the first time, or whether you would like to consolidate your own understanding to support what you currently teach, we hope that this CPD opportunity will prove invaluable.

## COURSE CONTENT

We hope to run all six groups, provided there is sufficient interest. Please note the timings vary between courses and the A Level Class Civ group only runs Wednesday-Friday.

### 1: Beginners' Latin

Trainer: Wendy Smith

Dates and times: 4 x 2 hour sessions on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th August (11am - 1pm)

Content: This course will use Cambridge Latin Course Book 1 and will provide a solid introduction to the basics of Latin grammar.

### 3: Primary Latin

Trainer: Charlie Andrew

Dates and times: 4 x 2 hour sessions on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th August (10am- 12noon)

Content: This course will enable you to teach Units 1-5 of the Maximum Classics course - an engaging course for KS2 pupils covering foundation Latin language and culture.

### 5: Teaching Latin Literature at GCSE

Trainer: Otti Olivero

Dates and times: 4 x 2 hour sessions on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th August (11am - 1pm)

Content: This group will focus on Eduqas Component 2 (Latin Literature and Sources). The first session will give a general overview of Component 2, with sessions 2-4 focusing on the 'Magic and Superstition' option.

### 2: Intermediate Latin

Trainer: Steve Hunt

Dates and times: 4 x 2 hour sessions on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th August (10am - 12noon)

Content: This group will support teachers who already have some knowledge of Latin and who would now like to teach up to GCSE. The primary focus will be on translating (and teaching how to translate) GCSE unseen language passages with the Eduqas qualification.

### 4: Beginners' Greek for ICCG

Trainer: Stuart Macaulay

Dates and times: 4 x 2 hour sessions on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th August (9-11am)

Content: This course is for those who are relatively new to learning Ancient Greek (knowledge of the alphabet will be assumed) but who are interested in teaching the new Intermediate Certificate in Classical Greek. We'll aim to cover Chapters 1-4 of John Taylor's Greek to GCSE Part 1.

### 6: Teaching A Level Class Civ

Trainer: Mike Beer

Dates and times: 3 x 2 hour sessions on 24th, 25th, 26th August (11am - 1pm)

Content: We will tailor course content to the interests and needs of those attending. Please indicate which modules you will be/are teaching on the sign up form.
