**BOUDICA is charged as follows:**

**Count 1**

**STATEMENT OF OFFENCE**

**BEING A TERRORIST** contrary to section 1 of the Terrorism Act 2000

**PARTICULARS OF OFFENCE**

BOUDICA, between the first day of January 60 and the first day of January 62, used action involving serious violence against persons, namely the inhabitants of Camulodunum, Londinium and Verulamium, and/or involving serious damage to the property of the same persons and to public property, and/or endangering the lives of those persons, and/or creating a serious risk to their health and safety, in that she raised an army and led, instructed and caused it to destroy Camulodunum, Londinium and Verulamium, and to kill the inhabitants, and her action was designed to influence the government of Rome or to intimidate the public or a section of the public, for the purpose of advancing a political or ideological cause, namely Icenii dissidence and secession.
